**Details of Activities**  
**Department of Social Work**  
**April 2017- July 2018**

### **1. Study Tour**

The Department of Social Work, Maulana Azad National Urdu University conducts study tour of MSW semester IV students every year. In the month of February 2018, students (2016-18 batch) were exposed to Department of social work, Agra University, Agra, Uttar Pradesh. The students also visited *Institute of Mental Health* and Hospital and *Ramlal Viridha Ashram* of Agra as part of study tour.

### **2. Students' Participation in National Integration Camp in New Delhi**

A group of 10 students participated in a week long National Integration Camp organised by Department of Social Work, JMI, New Delhi from 23<sup>rd</sup> December to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018. The students had an opportunity to interact with student and teachers from various social work departments and institutes, field practitioners and social work educators. They participated in Nukkar Natak competition and represented the University through cultural performances.

### **3. Invited Guest Lectures**

**3.1)** A lecture on “**Child Rights**” was organized on 08.09.2017 in the department. The resource person was Mr. Ravindra Kumar Kona (Director, SOS Children Village, Hyderabad Branch). He provided a holistic understanding of children as a vulnerable group and also discussed the practical implications of child rights in Indian context.

**3.2)** A lecture on “**Health and Social Work Intervention**” was organized on 18.10.2017 in the department. Dr. Renu Kapoor (General Manage, Family Planning Association of India, Hyderabad Branch) was invited to speak and interact with students on “Health and Social Work Intervention”. She spoke on health in general and reproductive health from gender justice angle in particular. Dr. Kapoor illustrated her organizational contribution towards ensuring reproductive and sexual rights of marginalised women.

**3.3)** An **Online Interactive session** with Students was organized on 27.10.2017 in the department. Ms. Saba Kaleem, an Australia based social work professional, interacted with MSW students and research scholars about her journey as a professional. She delivered a motivational talk to infuse students with positive energy to work hard in this profession.

**3.4)** A lecture on “**Digital Social Work**” was organized on 14.11.2017 in the department. Prof. Abdul Matin, Professor of Sociology, AMU, discussed the new prospects in social work in the time of technology and how technology could be a useful resource to overcome several social issues.

**3.5)** A lecture on “**Contemporary Social Movements in India**” was organized on 02.02.2018 in the department. Ms. Meera Sanghamitra, a social activist and human rights professional, was invited to talk on the relevance and need of social movements across the country thriving to ensure justice to marginalised communities and vulnerable groups.

### **4. NGO Meet cum Exhibition**

The NGO Meet was organised at the Department of Social Work, MANUU Campus on 13.03.2018, at 11:00 am. The program consisted of a meeting with agency supervisors followed by an exhibition by the agencies. The Registrar and the Controller of Examinations, MANUU, graced the occasion with their presence.

## **5. Celebration of Important Days**

5.1 International Non-violence Day: The day was on 03.02.2018 in the department. The program included posters and placards demonstration, speech and poetry recitation. Teachers and students from other departments also participated in the program. On the day, the importance and philosophy of Mahatma Gandhi was highlighted by Prof. Mohd Shahid (COE, MANUU), Dr. Md Shahid Raza (HoD, Social Work), Dr. Afroz Alam (HoD, Political Science) and Dr. Faheem Akhtar (Islamic Studies).

On this occasion, the wall magazine of the department was depicted with the life and message of Mahatma Gandhi on nonviolence and peace.

5.2 International Mother Language Day: International Mother Language day was observed on 21.2.2018 in the department. Students and teachers expressed their views in their mother languages followed by an address by the head, Department of Social Work.

5.3 International Women's Day: The department celebrated "International women's Day" on 08.03.2018. The program was followed by speeches, extempore, poetry recitation on the theme, Quiz Competition and Skit Performance. The issues of women as a pertinent concern in social work were reflected through activities.

## **6. Music cum Talk**

A music cum talk was organized by the department on 23.03.2018 on the occasion of death anniversary of Bhagat Singh in Conference Hall, Centre for Urdu Culture Studies. Prof. Subhendu Ghosh (Head, Bio physics, University of Delhi) presented Aazadi ke Taraane from the rich legacy of Urdu-Hindi Nazams and Ghazals. Students and teachers from various departments attended this event.
